WK Kellogg Co has filed an official WARN Notice with the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development, notifying the agency of a permanent layoff effective August 7, 2026, through October 2, 2026. The affected location is located at 2168 Frisco Avenue, Memphis, TN 38114. The total number of affected workers is 117. This includes both union-represented and non-represented employees. The company

notified the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development's Dislocated Worker Unit on June 5, 2026.

The applicable collective bargaining agreement will govern union-represented employees at the facility, and non-union-represented employees do not have bumping rights. The Greater Memphis Local Workforce Development Area rapid response team, employed by the Greater Memphis Chamber, has been notified to coordinate services with the employer and affected employees. The Greater Memphis Local Workforce Development Board will be responsible for the oversight of and the continued follow-up of Rapid Response and Dislocated Worker services associated with this event.
